# INSIGHTS *with Fr. Charlie*

## Jesus, the *Trusted Servant*

From the beginning, Jesus' approach to His ministry was a revolutionary idea. Think about it. *Serving others* vs. creating a *kingdom* for Himself was radical for a leader. Wherever He traveled, Jesus demonstrated his conviction by being a living example of a *Trusted Servant*— and He clarified His intentions with these words: *The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve...* His commitment never faltered. His example endures.

Our parish family is blessed with many *Trusted Servants*. Watching and experiencing how many of you discover ways to *serve one another* and contribute to our parish is a rewarding part of my work.
