INSIGHTS with Fr.Charlie

Jesus Revealed The First Feast Day | January 6

"The holy day has dawned upon us: Come and adore the Lord, for a great light has come down upon earth."

Did you know that *The Epiphany of Our Lord Jesus Christ* was the *first* feast day? Its earliest reference was in 361 A.D. Roman historian, Ammianus Marcellinus quoted Saint Epiphanius writing about January 6: *Hemera genethlion toutestin epiphanion*, meaning it is *Christ's birthday; that is, his epiphany.*"

The word *epiphany* comes from the Greek word, *epiphaneia*, meaning *"manifestation"* or *"sudden appearance."* The origin of the observance of Epiphany started in the Eastern Christian Church. They mark Jesus' revelations by four significant happenings:

- Jesus' birth.
- The visit to Bethlehem by the Magi in search of a heavenly king and their adoration of Him.
- Jesus childhood and life events, up to and including his Baptism in the River Jordon by John the Baptist.
- Manifestation of Jesus' public ministry and His first Miracle at the Wedding at Cana in Galilee: The transformation of the water into wine.

In the Western Christian tradition, our emphasis focuses on Jesus' revelations to the Gentiles mentioned in Luke's Gospel: "He is a Light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel." (Luke 2:32) Gentiles mean non-Jewish people; in the Bible, the Magi represent the non-Jewish people of the world. The essence of the feast days in both the Eastern and the Western Christian traditions is the same; we both celebrate the manifestations of Jesus being revealed to the people of the world.

The Epiphany of our Lord has a personal significance to each of us today. John spoke it this way: "This is how God showed His love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him."

(1 John 4:9)
