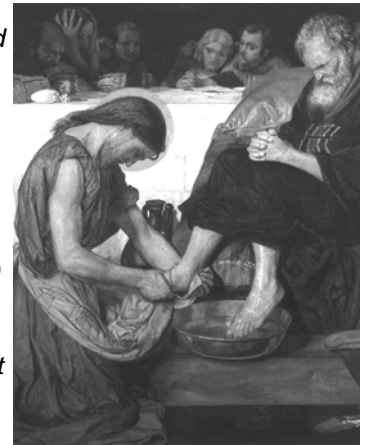

Holy Thursday
Commemorating the Lord's Supper

There is one ritual during Lent that you won't want to miss. It is the *Mass of the Lord's Supper* on Holy Thursday (also known as Maundy Thursday). This special mass marks the beginning of the Easter Triduum, the first day of the 3-day ceremony, where we mystically recall the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Learning from Jesus

Jesus “*rose from supper and took off his outer garments. He took a towel and tied it around his waist. Then He poured water into a basin and began to wash His disciples' feet and dry them with the towel...*”(John 13:4-5) When He was finished, he explained, “*I have given you an example to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do.*”



(John 13:15)

It was at the Lord's Supper that Jesus also gave us *mandatum* or mandate: “*I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another.*” (John 13:34)

You're invited to join us Holy Thursday as we begin our commemorative walk towards Easter as a parish family. I encourage you to participate in your own way; come to pray, support, and take-in the meaning and beauty in this ritual experience and help us welcome Jacob and Charise as they prepare to be new members of the Catholic Church.
