# INSIGHTS with Fr. Charlie

## The Work of the Holy Spirit The Meaning of Its Symbols

"... It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor [the Holy Spirit] will not come to you; I will send him to you." — Jesus (John 16:7)

We learn about the work of the Holy Spirit in each of the Gospels and in other books of the Bible. It is often expressed with descriptive symbols. We see them in religious art, the decor of our churches, and hear them in the



liturgies of our faith; below are four examples:

**Dove:** One of the most common symbols of the Holy Spirit comes from the story of Jesus' Baptism when He saw "the Spirit, like a dove, descending upon him." (Mark 1:10) Luke, Matthew, and John also described the Holy Spirit at Jesus' Baptism with similar words and the symbol of the dove.

**Water:** The symbolism of water signifies the Holy Spirit's action in our Baptism. The water of Baptism is the sacramental sign of our birth into the divine life given to us by the Holy Spirit. It is also symbolized in the living water, welling up from Christ crucified, as our source of eternal life. (John 19:34).

**Anointing:** In Christian initiation, anointing is the sacramental sign of our Confirmation, accomplished by the Holy Spirit. The anointing with oil is the symbol of the Holy Spirit uniting us with Jesus, the Messiah, the Anointed One. (1 John 20-27) In Hebrew, "messiah" means the one "anointed."

**Fire:** "I have come to bring fire on the earth...," Jesus said. (Luke 12:49) The fire symbolizes the strength and transforming energy of the Holy Spirit. An example: "When the day of Pentecost came, ...they saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that came to rest on each of them. They were filled with the Holy Spirit." (Acts of the Apostles 2:3).

Jesus gave us this promise: "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever — the Spirit of Truth. ...He lives with you and will be in you."
