INSIGHTS with Fr. Charlie

Holy Queen Isabel Renewing and Remembering Her at Pentecost

Last fall, we rediscovered Queen Isabel of Portugal here in our parish! Outside the Parish Hall, there had been a plaque on the wall mistakenly identifying the statue of the beautiful woman as St. Teresa of Avila, one of the four Doctors of the Church. However, her golden crown made it clear that she is a Queen, not a Doctor, so we reintroduced her inspiring story.*

Queen Isabel has strong ties to the Portuguese heritage of our parish, which gives special significance to her statue. Unfortunately, it has long been in a dark corner, badly damaged. Recently, Sally K. Green volunteered to restore the statue in time for the Holy Ghost Festival (Festa Doespirito Santo) and Maria Machado assisted her by donating the cost of the paint. This weekend, the RENNOVATED statue of Queen St. Isabel will be in the main vestibule of the church for veneration.

About the Holy Ghost Festival:

The first feast was held during the reign of Queen Isabel. This is the story: After a series of violent earthquakes and volcanic eruptions, the Portuguese people of the Azores Islands were struck with drought and famine. With little left, they gathered together to pray for help from the Holy Spirit (Holy Ghost). On Pentecost Sunday, there was a great rising sun — in the distance, they saw a ship coming into port. It carried the necessities of life they needed.



When Queen Isabel heard of God's blessings on her people, she organized a solemn procession in honor of the Holy Ghost. She carried her Crown through the streets of Lisbon to the cathedral, where she left it on the altar as an offering of thanksgiving. Since then, many Portuguese churches display replicas of her crown, as we do at Our Lady of the Pillar at Pentecost, in remembrance of her goodness and God's grace. Queen Isabel said it best herself, "God made me queen so that I may serve others."
