THE WAY OUT

Today's readings launch us into Lent with the story of salvation. How did we humans get where we are? How do we get out? Genesis—through the Adam and Eve narrative—explains that we became separated from God and happiness through greed, selfishness and arrogance. But, as Paul explained to the Romans, God has not abandoned us, and never will. We get out through the "new Adam," Jesus Christ, through whom the death of sin is conquered by the life of "overflowing grace." From the start, though, Jesus—like Adam and Eve, like you and me—had to face "the tempter." Shown fame and wealth, he was tempted to grab for it. But Jesus saw through such foolishness. During Lent we will look at what the tempter spreads before us daily, then try to make choices that put us on the side of the angels.

Las lecturas de hoy inician la Cuaresma con la historia de la salvación. ¿Cómo llegamos nosotros los humanos a donde estamos? ¿Cómo salimos de aquí? Génesis —en el relato sobre Adán y Eva— explica que nos hemos separado de Dios y de la felicidad a causa de la avaricia, el egoísmo y el orgullo. Pero, como Pablo explica a los romanos, Dios no nos ha abandonado y nunca lo hará. Salimos por medio del "nuevo Adán", Jesús, quien ha conquistado la muerte del pecado con la vida de "gracia sin medida". Desde el principio, sin embargo, Jesús —igual que Adán y Eva, igual que tú y yo— tuvo que enfrentarse al "tentador". Cuando le mostró la fama y la riqueza, fue tentado a poseerlas. Pero Jesús entendió que eran una bobería. Durante la Cuaresma consideraremos lo que el tentador nos pone ante nuestros ojos diariamente, y trataremos de escoger lo que nos pone del lado de los ángeles.

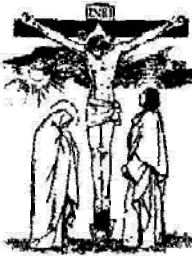
