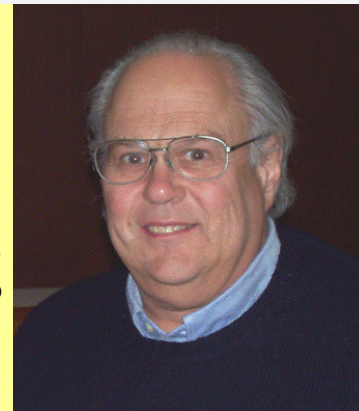
Knights of the Month
